Sometimes we did not manage to write all together on Russia, our ~~of~~ was always renewed to be gone. - We really spend a very nice time together. Now I'm back in Stambul, and Turkey seem all here for a stay or two, or we are visiting here, and Mrs Zin's will do so separately from London. Did you get to winter home this for the books as you anti-protocol? - By now I suppose you have passed your exam with you and you when awaiting. Was it successful? -
It was quite a job to get Valley to write. He does not like to write letters, and because he

had not written to you for
over a long time if we did
all the more difficult, he did
not know ~~what~~ what, however,
now that he has done so I hope
he will keep it up.

I spoke to her on the phone
the other day. He is very happy
with his wife. He asked me about
you and I told him all you wrote
in this nice long letter. You call
me now and again. Forgive
me if possible, but I'm writing this
