You cannot imagine how glad I was to receive this letter from you. It is now more than a year since I got your last letter. But I forgive you now, hoping you will write me regularly from now. I am very sorry I did not receive your letter with the photo of your wedding. I did not answer you immediately, for we moved this week to Kwuzat Jawne. We have finished yet our learning at Kfar Hanear, and now we went to Kwuzat Jawne (it is the first religious kibbutz in Palestine.) for one year, to see and learn the life in the kibbutz. Afterwards we will continue and establish ourselves on our own ground.

After 3 months I shall have to pass my matriculation and then I shall begin to learn at the university. First I will stay one year at Jawne learning practical work of agriculture by direction of the university, and afterwards I will learn at Jerusalem.

Here at Jawne it is very nice; I like it here very much.

The aunts, Chane Hinde and Gitel are very much worried not having received any letter from Uncle Hershel since more than six months. I think you had better write me if any thing has happened, because not knowing, meditation and doubt, make much more sorrow and nervousness than even the worst news.

I am very sorry to tell, I did not have anything from our dear mother for more than a year. This war shall come to an end, and we all will be able to be together soon.

How do you do? What is on with Tuly. Why does he not write? Please send my new address to Fey.
