I hope this letter finds you well. We received your letter & we were glad to hear that you are well. I am going to a secondary school here, and I like very much. My 8 weeks summer holiday is just finishing, and I have enjoyed them very much. I went to camp for two weeks, with a lot of other Jewish children, we were living in tents. I liked it very much. I also stayed with Sara & Chaim in London for quite a while.

I suppose you know, that, before I came to live with Guggy (that was over a year ago), I stayed with some people in "Sunderland". Sunderland is in the N.E. of England, on the coast. The people I lived with, were very nice and orthodox. Last summer I came to live with Guggy, and I have been here ever since.

It is such a long time since I saw you last. Do you remember me at all. If you can, will you please send me a photo from you. I am sending you a little snap from me, just to revive your memory of what I look like. I know this letter won't reach you until another 3 months time, so it will be no use sending you new years greetings now. I am looking forward to 1943, and I hope it will be good one for all of us and you.
