My dear Zim, Gov.,

May 20<sup>th</sup> 1945

At last Victory has come, at least in Europe, though a lot remains to be done. We here in England have been expecting it for quite some time, before it was actually made public, whether the crowds, especially in London, really need ~~know~~. There was an enormous amount of drinking, dancing and ringing in the streets, day and by night. It really is a thrill to be able to have lights on again. . . . However, as you rightly stated in your last letter, for us Jewish people

there only can be real Victory if we at least could have Palestine now, and could make it a home for so many who have had to suffer so much these last few years under such terrible oppression. I'd alone know what terrific news there may be in store for a lot of us. — I'm thinking of our dear mother day and night, and praying she may have been spared for us. After all, we have lost so much already. . . .

Now to answer your question. Unfortunately the majority of Jews here in England do not realize the importance of a Jewish national state for us. It is mostly people who have ears

have from other countries of the  
 continent, where they were felt  
 more, where are the real idealists  
 in their direction, although  
 I must pay out - penitence in  
 atoning by strictness. In the  
 upper classes as well as in  
 the lower. Though I myself
