coming again for 1946.

it would be if you dear Jim's could have been here with us to complete the five of us.

To think we have not seen each other so many years, it seems unbelievable.

And if I only know how much longer it will be before we will meet again once more in freedom. And I will be able to introduce uncle Jim's to Ruthy.

She is a very good girl, quite grown up and I may say a clever little one.

Chaim's is very well. He had a few weeks holiday from his thirteenth school, which is beginning again in a weeks time.

We went to West-cliff (not far from London) and had a very nice holiday there on the sea-side.

Do you remember a Mrs. Werfel who was in England several months ago, and brought you regards from us? Well, her

Bunbarel used to be a leader of a "Hevra" in Leuberg to which Chaim used to belong. If you have the opportunity to speak to him, you might ask if he remembers Chaim. Chaim remembers Mr. Werfel very well.
